EVERSO MISCHIEVOUS two to thr ee wide in pursuit, advanced on the leader in ta ndem with FILM STAR to his outside thr ee furlongs from home, came under coax ing at the five-sixte enths, swung fourwideinto upperstretch seizing narr ow command, dug in under threat from a tr io and then quart et and gam ely fended them off to thefinish. DR ARDIT0 chased four then tw o wide coming under coax ing at the thr ee-eighths, angled fiv eto six wideinto upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to just get up for the place honors in the final jump. ACCRETIVE chased five wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, went eight wideinto upper str etch, dug in under a drive rallying willingly through to thefinish but was ultimately repelled to the wire. FILM STAR broke in at the start, chased just off the pace four wide down the backstretch before advancing on the lea der four to five wide midway on the turn, offered up a bid swinging six wideinto upper stretch, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages. SWIFTSURE showed the way in hand along the inside, took to the two path through the turn coming under pressure from a pair midway on the bend, got placed to coaxing in response at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and yielded the front straightened away, the n weakened in the late going. BUSINESS MODEL five wide early on, tucked inside with nine-sixte enths to go, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper str etch and made no impact. DOUBLE CROWN chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, tir ed.
