STROLLINGINTHEWIND saved ground well off the pace, bid past the sev en sixteenths pole but was blocke dat the rail on the far turn and flattened str ide the final sixteenth. HONE YQUIST took a quick lead and moved to the inside to rate the pace, was met into the backstretch, cameunder pressure leaving the three eighths pole, gave up the lead toward the quarter and weakened in the stretch. PAYMENGOLD rated closeinsideon the first turn, gav echase leav ing the three eight hs polebutw eakene dat therailinto the far turn. GRU MPY'S BUDDY raced in thefour path thefirst turn, picked up the chasefrom theseven sixteenths polebut showed little response. DUNCANIDAHO stalked off the rail, moved to even terms into the backstretch and gave chase from the three eighths pole, but weakened off the rail on the far turn. SUMMONING DENIS raced off the rail on the first turn and never factored. JAZZ WITH DENIS settled in the three path thefirst turn and was not a factor.
