If more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Colts and Geldings (2) High Weights with the scale of weights considered, (3) Highest Lifetime Earnings will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights (4) Highest Lifetime Earnings. KING ICE unhurrie dearly to be well off the pace, quickly made up ground entering the turn to make four wide bid at the quarter pole, took command in mid-stretch and drew away in a well handled ride. MAN SFIELD TIGER reserved off the pace in mid-pack, rallied five wide and closed well to gain the place. CASH LOGISTICS rated in hand for the run down the backside, made a steady gain and dug-in between horses to just miss the place but gain the show in a three horse photo. ONE BIG DUDE stalked the pace to thefar turn, ranged up three wide to take the lead on the bend, could not go with the winner and was out-finished in the final strides for the minor placings. GRAND IN BAY slow early to trail through the first turn, continued on near the rear into the far turn and mounted a belated rally down the lane. D'ORO'S WISH went one-paced lacking a rally. BLUEGRASS PRAYER raced near the rear of the field most of the way and passed tiring rivals down the lane. MR CHAOS tracked the leaders through the far turn, loomed in upper stretch and flattened out in the lane. LATIGO rated in striking position down the backside, mounted an early bid threatening in the turn and weakened turning for home. TAILLIGHTS was never a threat. PRINCE SHIM set the pace to the far turn and came up empty. ON THE RAYDAR pressed the pace to the three-eighths pole and stopped in the turn.
