ARASHI switched outside the aforementioned to stalk that one three wide, was no match but second best. KINGROSSO was coaxed briefly from the break then allowed to settle off the leading pair on or just off the railthroughout, ran on evenly. ENGLISH JUBILEE was forced out a bit at the start, angled in, saved ground inside through the turn, came out a bit in upper stretch, ran on. WAR PAINTER got away well, settled in to stalk from off the pace, went four wide on the turn adv ancing rapidlyto within rangec oming past the three-eighths but evened out thereafter. ZIPPY GIZM0 raced off the paceoutside four wide, swung out seven wide into upper stretch, showed late interest. AWESOME ENTRY broke just a half-stepslowly, race dat the back off the inside going in the two to three path thr ough the turn, passed tired rivals. PONTIAC was forced out just a bit at the start, raced betw een foes three wideand off the pace into the turn, encouraged along past the five-sixteenths, cameout five wide turning for home, lacked the needed late kick. BEARING DOWN raced outside mostly four to six wide, failed to rally.
