SPUN GLASS was outpaced in the early going racing last but one, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, encouraged along by the top of the stretch while guided out, split rivals four deep coming past the sixteenth pole taking the lead and holding sway. AWESOME TREAT broke just a tadawkwardly but was none the worse, settled off the pace two to three wide into the turn, moved out five widec om ing int o upperstretch a nd loomed a thr eat, was out kicked by the winnerbut secured the place. LOYALTY pressed then prompted the pace from outside two to three wide, took the leadabout the five-sixteenths, moved clear into upper stretch, was ot ukicked. HAZELBROOK pursued from between runners on the sec ond flight moving out from thr ee to four wide past the quarter pole, loomed a threat in upper str etch but could only run on evenly late. SOUPER MUNNINGS broke a step slowly, lacked early speed bringing up the rear along theinside, came out for the stretch run, kicked on well but too late. READYTO VENTURE (GB) was outsprinted in a scramble for the early lead then content to track in behind racing inside foes but just off the rail, kept on ev enly in the stretch. OUR FLASH DRIVE was well-placedstalking a liv ely pace four to five wide, moved out six to seven deep for the stretch run, lacked the needed late kick. ARTIE' S PRIN CESS raced outside off the pace five to six wide on the turn, swung out a bit further for the drive, failed to rally. HARDEDGE was stoutly ur ged from the start, set a pressured pace inside, weakened inthe stretch.
