LADY WELLINGTON tracked in the second flight on the rail down the backside, was asked midturn making little gain on the leaders but opened on fellow rival for third position through the turn, faded in mid-stretch and held for a minor share at wire. GRADEVOLE broke out at the start, co-trailed in the third flight on the outside down the backstretch, made little impression running ar ound the bend and could not get into contention driv ing to the finish line. RED ELEANOR co-trailed on the inside down the backstraight, made no im pact throughout the turn running inside on the rail and showed little in the stretch drive.
