OLIVIA ROSE took control from the onset setting a soft opening first quarter unopposed, continued strongly up front unchallenged running throughout the turn, was set down in upper stretch, easily cleared of fand won going away in a very convincing front end display. HURRICANE CLAIR was content to sit off the winner outside down the backstretch, midturn was roused to go after the loosefront runner but could not close the gap, chased in upper stretch but to no availand finished up comfortably besting the rest for the runners up share. FOURFIFTYFOUR tracked the front two on the outside at the half, was scrubbed on with five sixteenths to go but could not gain top the top three runners around the bend, gamely never gave up and fought on late to close in capturing third money in the final sixteenth. LADY WELLINGTON tracked in the second flight on the rail down the backside, was asked midturn making little gain on the leaders but opened on fellow rival for third position through the turn, faded in mid-stretch and held for a minor share at wire. GRADEVOLE broke out at the start, co-trailed in the third flight on the outside down the backstretch, made little impression running around the bend and could not get into contention driving to the finish line. RED ELEANOR co-trailed on the inside down the back straight, made no impact throughout the turn running inside on the rail and showed little in the stretch drive.
