TRADE MARK tracked behind the leaders and from the two path, pursued from the pocket with run around the far turn, took aim on the leaders from the four path and among rivals entering the lane, rallied to bid at the furlong grounds, sparred through the late stages and narrowly prevailed. FIRST MISSION vied along the inside, led in upper stretch, shifted out to meet TRADE MARK's challenge at the furlong grounds, gamely battled with that one through the late stages but missed via a tight photo. IL MIRACOLO laid off of the pace in the two path, took closer order before pursuing in the three path into the far turn, shifted to the four path and between rivals turning for home before floating to the six path entering the lane, then stayed on while shifting inwardly and gained show from an outer foe at the sixteenth pole. BLUE DEVIL lacked speed along the inside, shifted to the five path entering the backstretch, pursued in the four path around the far turn, shifted ground outside of rivals passing the three sixteenths pole and ran on willingly. GASOL INE laid off of the pace in the threeto four path around the first turn, pursued in the two to three path around the far turn, improved inside of rivals in upper stretch and failed to threaten. FILM STAR vied two wide but yielded between horses in upper stretch. STRAIGHTARROW pursued from midpack in the two to three path around the far turn chased in the four path into the far turn, got floated five wide turning for home then fanned to the seven path entering the lane and tired. GIANT GAME stalked outside of the leading pair, but faded in the five path and between horses entering the lane. STAGE RAIDER broke erratically and bucked leaving the gates many lengths behind the rest, lagged behind around both turns then narrowed the gap through the lane.
