JUST STEEL leaned out and brushe da rival at the start, chased four wide, pressed under urging at the three furlong pole, bid in the five path enter ing the lane, vied through midstretch while forging an advantage and inched away. AGOO tracked along the inside and sustained a rail grind to gain place at thesixteenth pole. NORMANDY HERO tracked three wide and bet ween horses, entered the lane blocked behind the leading group, altered course to the six path to be outside of them ent ering the final furlong, but only offered a mild kick to edge show. MOLL Y'S TOWN vied two wide and between horses, sparred with a pair of outer rivals while entering the lane in the three path, got headed nearing the furlong grounds and yielded between horses. BOOTH took light contact from an inner rival at the start, prompted the pace three wide, vied around the turn betw een horses, floated to the four path entering the lane then yielded passing the furlong grounds. GABARRA raced forwardly between horses early on, but yielded after a quarter mile, trailed ar ound the turn, swung out to the six path in upper stretch an surpassed tired rivals. BOWSTREET rushed after breaking flat-footedly, sparred with a pair of outer rivals into the turn, but weakenedinside of a trio of rivals at the five sixteenths pole. DIVIETO snagged theouter part of the starting gate upon leaving it, then was slow torecover, raced off of the pace in the four to three path, fadedandwas found to have bled.
