INTRICATE tracked along the inside, loomed a danger while pursuing from the pocket with run around the far turn, smoothly split the leaders two wide, gained an advantage in upper stretch, surged clear at the furlong grounds and was ridden out under moderate urging. THORPEDO ANNA hopped slightly and broke slow, recovered to track in the four to five path and outside of foes around the first turn, stalked three wide while inching closer around the far turn, bid in the four path entering the lane, but was outkicked by an inner rival in upper stretch, edged place in the final furlong and lasted from an outer bidder late. CENTRAL AVE NUE transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe at the start, laid off of the pace in the two path, was roused shifting to the four path around the far turn, chased in upper stretch, tipped further out at the furlong grounds and stayed on late to miss reaching place. DOZEN DIAMONDS shifted outside of the clear leader to stalk that one from the four path into the backstretch, chased two wide and between horses under coaxing around the far turn, bid drifting to the three path while among foes entering the lane, but allowed a seam for the eventual winner in the process, got outkicked by that one in upper stretch, lost place at the sixteenth pole and was bested for show. GIN GIN bumped an inner rival causing a chain-reaction at the start, pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, chased in the two path around the far turn and failed to menace. PURLOIN broke a step slow and took contact from an outer rival at the start, lacked speed in the two path, shifted out to the four path entering the lane and made little impact. HERE'S THE SPIDER received a bump from an outer rival at the start, bumped an inner foe and steadied back in the process, trailed in the three path, floated to the five path entering the laneand was outrun. WEST SUNSET tugged clear in the three path around the first turn, settled into stride before saying ground showing the way from chasing rivals around the far turn. but faltered inside of a trio of bidders in upper stretch and caved through the final fur long.
