DARK AFTERNOON ducked in at the start then was settled, made a bid but was no threat in the stretch drive. MESA MOON was allowed to settled then rallied and was five wide in the stretch but was no threat in the end. THAT'S SOMETHING broke in the air at the start then was unhurried early and no threat. FRIGERATOR chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, made a strong bid on the turn then faltered in the stretch. YANKEE INDIAN was unhurried early then raced six wide in upper stretch and was no threat.
