JIM'S HOPE travelled in midfield on the outside of horses down the backside, took closer order tracking three deep at the half, pounced three wide midpoint on the far turn, cleared away in mid-stretch and was kept to the task to hold safe at the finish. RAPID TEST stalked near the rear in the early stages, was roused for more three eighths from the line but did not quicken with others, could see the field at the top of the stretch and finally found another gear bursting by runners swinging out to the six path at the furlong pole to nab the place award at the wire. SOUPED UP had a good spot nestled behind the pacesetter down the backside, waited patiently behind the wall of the contesting front three runners at the quarter pole, angled in to the two path turning for home, battled stubbornly to the wire just missing out on holding for place in the end. CHASING TROUBLE co-trailed on the outside down the back straight, advanced three wide around foes with five sixteenths to run, loomed a threat outside in the five path straightening out for the drive but stalled late, losing a couple of placings at the wire. POULIN IN 0 T set a modest pace at the half, was collared outside by runners midway on the far turn, bravely fought on through the lane until the furlong marker and faded in deep stretch. GUNS N' ROJAS was allowed to settle trailing the field down the backstretch, saved ground advancing smartly through the far turn, was in range for a share on the fence at the top of the lane but could not offer a finishing bid to the wire. SILENT MIRACLE kept a close eye on the leader down the backstretch, bid for the lead in the two path with rivals on each side at the quarter pole, could not find more turning for home and yielded in mid-stretch.
