CHANCERY WAY away in good order, was asked for speed leaving the break and assumed command in the early going, carved out a solid pace while pressed into the turn, dictated terms while pressured to the quarter pole, shook free into upper stretch and kicked to a clear lead heading to the furlong marker, was kept to task into the final sixteenth and held safely in the end over the oncoming runner-up. SCARY FAST RIDE tracked the solid early pace from a two wide position, tracked between runners into the turn and made a mild gain at the guarter marker, shifted three wide into the stretch and chased CHANCERY WAY to the furlong grounds, closed well into the final sixteenth, was able to put mild pressure on the winner in deep stretch but could not reel that one in and was second best. ALL DIALED IN took back off of the quick early pace, tracked from the outside heading into the turn and chased two then three wide approaching the guarter marker, swung six wide into the stretch and chased to the furlong pole, closed willingly while widest in the final furlong, was not able to impact the top pair in deep stretch and out finished TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL in the final strides to secure third. TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL rated nicely off of the solid early pace, was not far back approaching the turn and chased two wide to the quarter marker, angled to the five path into upper stretch and chased to the furlong marker, was gaining in the final sixteenth and just missed for third at the wire. TAMARA MINE broke alertly, pressed the solid early pace outside of CHANCERY WAY, keptpressure on the pacesetter through quick fractions approaching the quarter pole, was repelled into the stretch and chased to the furlong grounds, lacked aresponse into deep stretch and gave way. BLUE WILDCAT chased the fast early pace from the outside, inched closer three wide at the quarter marker, tipped four wide for the drive, lost ground at the furlong marker and tired in the final stages. BABY KRISTEN bobbled at the start and was off slowly, rushed up in the opening furlong and raced close up to the solid early pace, lost ground while in pursuit heading to the quarter pole, dropped back in upper stretch and tired in the drive.
