OZARA (IRE) tracked the pace two wide between foes, angled four wide in upperstretch, closed outside, took over leaving the sixteenth pole and held firm inside of the runner-up. MILLIAT (IRE) broke a stepslowly, trailed inside early, edged closer two wide around the far turn, angled five wide in upper stretch and finished strongly. GREAT VENEZUELA set the pace in the two path, responded to a bid from BUTTERCREAM BABE nearing the quarter pole, re-cleared in upper stretch, led past the sixteenth pole and held third. BUTTERCREAM BABE prompted the pace three wide, bid nearing the quarter pole, continued on the left lead in the lane and was outfinished. MADAME MISCHIEF settled off the pacewhile racing two wide, went four wide around the far turn and had a mild stretch gain. CAIRO STREET went evenly inside. DONE ENOUGH had early speed at the rail, checked near the five-eighths marker, steadied again soon after, continued to chase inside around the far turn and weakened in the lane. BEACH CRUISER was bumped at the start, chased the pace three and four wide and lacked a closing bid. GOOD BRIGHT FLAMES failed to menace while racing two and three wide. MIST bumped at the start, raced off the pace two and three wide and made little further impact.
