SHAMANS GIRL was forced back at the start to trail, patiently settled into stride down the backstretch, began to close the gap on rivals on the turn, rallied three wide at the quarter pole, pounced to the lead at the furlong marker, switched leads and impressively drew away in deep stretch. VANDOO settled in midfield two wide outside of runners down the back straight, rallied three wide circling foes at the quarter pole, loomed four wide straightening out for the drive, was no match for the winner in the final eighth and stubbornlyheld on to be second best at the finish. LITTLE TEDDY travelled in mid-pack on the rail in the early going, progressed smartly on the fence at the quarter pole, was in the thick of things in the three path at the top of the lane and finished up solidly to the line just missing the place share crossing the wire. RED ELEANOR broke in sharply at the start, stalked near the rear on the rail down the backside, saved ground inching closer around the oval, drifted out wards through the lane driving to the wire and closed in late for a minor role in the end. ONELLA was hustled on the break to get the lead on the rail by the half mile marker, opened on the pack through the turn, was asking for the wirenarrowly holding onto the lead inside at the furlong pole and tired in deep stretch. MASTER ARAGORN broke alertly to have the lead in the beginning, was relegated to track the frontrunner down the backstretch, chased in vain the pacesetter around the bend, was nudged for more between foes at the quarter pole, had nothing to offer and yielded in upper stretch.
