GRAND SLAM SMILE dueled outside RECAL CITRANT, gained the advantage approaching the halfway point, relinquished the lead back to inner rival midway around thefar turn, fought between foes into the lane, inched ahead in upper stretch, shook free midstretch and drew away. ASADA FRIES stalked four wide outside apair of rivals on the clubhouse turn, chased the top pair three wide into thefar turn, bid outside the dueling leaders at the quarter pole, fought to the eighth pole, could not kick on with GRAND SLAM SMILE in the furlong grounds and stayed on to secure second. SUSHI STICKS lacked early speed and trailed on theinside in the early going, tipped off the fence on the far turn, steered out further in the lane, summoned a mild rally and got up for third. PRANCINGT HRUPARIS stalked inside rivals into the clubhouse turn then went two wide around the bend, remained two wide through the far turn, finished willingly down the lane but was outkicked for third. MADISON RAE brushed the gate and bobbled shortly after, chased four deep and got caught five wide into the first turn, quickly cut back inside and settled in the two path outside a rival, rounded the second bend two then three wide, kept on through the lane and got edged for the show honors. RECALCITRANT took a short lead dueling from inside early, lost command nearing the half-mile pole, took control again on the far turn, fought inside a pair of rivals into the lane, lost command in upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. R SWEET CANDY chased between rivals three wide on the clubhouse turn, navigated the second bend three then two wide outside a rival and weakened. PETIT FILET chased from inside off the pace, saved ground to the stretch and was not a factor.
