MANNY WAH chased three then two wide down the backstretch before tucking along the inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on clear for the place honors. KINETIC SKY chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, im proved position to sec ure the show honors. STAGE LEFT chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages.
