HALINA'S FORTE chased six then five wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths and advancing on the leader, swung fivewide into upper stretch, ral lied to take command a fur long out, edged away under a drive to prevail. GHAL IA PRINCESS dueled from the two path with RECONCILE to her outside, shook off that rival three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared at the eighth pole, ran on willingly to the finish. VALUE AREA broke in at the start bumping MOST OF ALL into LOW SOCIETY, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors. LOW SOCIETY got bumped at the start by MOST OF ALL due to pressure from VALUE AREA breaking inwards, chased just off the inside under coaxing from midway on the turn, angled four wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. RECONCILE got bumped at the start by TIARELLA and bobbled, led briefly before dueling three wide with GHALIA PRINCESS to her inside, got shake off three furlongs from home and came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths when joined outside by the eventual winner, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. TIARELLA brokein a step at the start bumping RECONCILE and forcing that foe to bobble, raced five then four wide just off the duel, came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. MOST OF ALL got bumped at the start by VALUE AREA and in turn bumped LOW SOCIETY, chased four wide until tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing midway on the turn, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.
