CLASSIC CAUSEWAY cleared to the inside into the first turn, showed the way under stout restraint past the wire the first time, continued to set a semi pressured pace the middle half mile, clear again into the stretch for the final time, nailed in the very late going. SPEED BIAS within striking distance off the inside, remained within contact while three wide through the final turn, lacked a closing punch in the drive. RED RUN broke with the runner up, chased that one under restraint most of the way, weakened in the drive. O P FIRECRACKER settled in mid pack, advanced and loomed a threat four wide turning for home, hung in the drive. GAME KEEPER worked way to the inside about halfway through, continued one paced to the wire in lacked a closing response. COMMANDPERFORMANCE four wide through the first two turns while well off the pace, three wide through thethird, also failed to produce a rally. STRONGTIDE saved ground to no avail throughout. MASTER GAME forwardly place dearly outside, remained four wide and tired. DOUBLE CROWN was always back to be outrun. DECISION MAKER was last away, was never close.
