#### Abstract

By subscription of $\$ 100$ each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of $\$ 6,000$ at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). $\$ 1,500$ to enter and an add itional $\$ 1,500$ to star $t$, with $\$ 300,000$ guaranteedplus an additional $\$ 100,000$ KT DF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of $1.25 \%$ to each owner of horses finishing sixth through last, $62 \%$ of the remaining association purse will be paid to the owner of the winner, $20 \%$ to second, $\mathbf{1 0 \%}$ to third, $5 \%$ to fourth, $3 \%$ to fifth. KTDF funds correspondingly divided providing a KTDF eligible horse finishes in an award position. Weight: 123 lbs . Non-winners of a Grade I stak es allowed 3 lbs.; a graded stak es 5 lbs . The maximum number of starters for the Lafaayette will be limited to twelve with four also eligible. In the event that more than tw elve hors es pass the entry box, the twe lve starters will be deter mined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highestearnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a set of two silver julep cups to the winning o wner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, March 20, 2024 with 28 Nominations.

WHO DEY pursuedfrom midpack in the thr ee path, lacked progress in upper stretch before shifting inwardly at the furlong grounds, then offered rail im provement in the finalfurlong to reach place in the closing stages. FROSTY INDULGENCE broke inwar dly while off slow, recovered to track along the inside, shifted out while gaining place from an outer foe in the final furlong, but was bested by an inner bidder for that position late. DON CHO stalkedallowing an outer rival to show the way down the backstretch, moved outside of that one to press with ahalf mile to go, chased among foes turning for home, failed to keep pace with the clearing leader in upper stretch, lost place to an inner rival at the sixteenth pole and yielded. BOOTH stalked in the four path and gave way. BAYTOWN CHATTERBOX laid off of the pace in the two path and tired. BOLT AT MIDNIGHT trailed in the four path and got outr un.
