SPEEDYNESS, bumped at the break, took over early and set the pace towards the inside, moved away under a ride in upper stretch, kept on gamely through the final furlong but just could not fend off the winner's charge. INVEIGLED settled in the clear while not far back, edged up thr ee wide near the half then gave hard chase, raced between rivals approaching the stretch, br ushed with COPPER TAX soon after, pursued to the inside of that one past mid stretch, kept on with effort and saved the show. CAROLORAPID0, bumped and intight four wide betwe en foes soon int o the first turn, raced three wide between runners past the thr ee quarters, gained off the inside then w or ked between foes in upper stretch, shifted inward and finished with good courage. LAT LONG, bumped and in tight at the break, regrouped and raced bet ween runners into the backstretch, was put to urging and started an advance hea ding to the half, took closer or der leaving the three eighths, angled five wide approaching the stretch, continued with effortto mid stretch then flattene dout late. STARTSWITHADREAM checked repeatedly and bumped with an outer rival when difficult to settle into and around the first turn, dropped back to last, saved ground past the five sixteenths, shifte doutbut failed to make a serious recovery. CEL TIC CONTENDER, bumped with CIRCLE P then an inner rival at the break, was put to snug rating early while saving ground, eased out to go arounda tired rival leaving the far turn, shifted back in near the five sixteenths, chased, faltered and was eased late. CIRCLE P broke inward bumping with CELTIC CONTEDER, was wrangled back soon after then checked along into and through the early part of the backstretch, went erratic ally near the five eighths, raced bet ween foes under some rat ing near ing the lane, gav eway and was eased late. CLASSIC JOKE brokeoutward, corrected and pulled his way for ward into the first turn, settled better while stalking inside through the backstretch, chased past the five sixteenths, faltered in upper stretch and was eased late. MALINOIS stalked outside the lea der early on, faltered leav ing thefar turn, was eased through the lane then was pulled upshortly past the wirewhile bleeding.
