PATTON'S TIZZY broke sharp, set the pace inside, dueled through the turn, found more past the furlong marker to put that rival away and then just held ther unner up safe late to gain the nod. LANDLORD in the second flight under light restraint inside, continued to track the dueling leaders through the turn, shifted to the outside for the drive, late bid outside the winner, missed. CHEZ WHIZ void of speed for a half, swung out widest for the drive, closed with good energy out in the strip to be rapidly getting to the top two late. TWENTY TOPARK forwardly placed while just off the inside, loomed closer three wide turning for home, flattened out the final furlong to finish up evenly. STRIKE RIDGE away in good order, pressed the issue winner early from the outside, dueled through the turn and into upper str etch, first to blink past the fur long mar ker. GOD'S COUNTRY lacked speed, four wide exiting the turn, improved position with some modest late interest without posing a threat. HOLUS BOLUS went one paced throughout while racing in the tw o path. RANCH HAND in the second flight outside, fell back turn, not a threat through the lane. TOUCHDOW N ARKANSAS in the second flight while racing three wide, gave way in the drive. ROCKET SANDERS remained back while racing inside.
