MISS SKY WARRIOR broke alertly and quickly established control, cut the fractions, being rated along from the rail, with the main pressure coming from a lightly urged LIBBY'S TAIL out in path two, saw the runner up increase her presence during the last half of the run around the second bend, was challenged by a pair of foes heading into the stretch, settled in before having the rider resort to a drive, gave up ground in the final furlong drifting out at times from a left handed whip, but held sway. JAMYSON 'N GINGER settled into midpack after an apparent clean getaway, got rated stalking the winner from midpack, tipped outward coming to the conclusion of the backstretch, stepping off it from the four path, managed to work a tuck closer to the rail soon afterwards as SPIRITUALITY was calling it a day, closed in enough so to issue a challenge as the widest of threesome spinning into the stretch, whittled away at the deficit, particularly after leaving the sixteenth pole and despite drifting to the outside, fell short. BONITA BIANCA was taken hold after getting pinched in the shadow of the starting gate, was one-paced racing at or near the inside during the opening phases, displayed some life getting angled out into path four as three-quarters was being reached, swung about as wide into the stretch, rallied in a steadfast manner to garner the show, although never posing a threat to the top twosome. LIBBY'S TAIL pressed the issue from the two path, was between rivals turning for home, lacked the necessary stretch response and gave way. MAJESTIC BONNIE bumped soundly with LADIES DAY as the field was sent off and running, darted over towards the inside, was on the move to the outside coming to the half mile pole, raced four to three wide on the turn two, loosely drafting behind the second place finisher, headed into the stretch but made no impact. ELANDESS strung out three wide on the clubhouse bend, continued from off the inside, failed to menace. ROMANTIC MUSIC tracked the front runners from the pocket, pulling on the bit early, failed to respond when asked to at the five-sixteenths marker and faltered. SPIRITUALITY three wide on both turns, was through after going three-quarters. LADIES DAY bumped soundly with MAJESTIC BONNIE after stumbling badly at the break, raced from off the inside throughout, travelled three to four wide on the turn and tired.
