

1 1/8 MILES. (1.47) 103RD RUNNING OF THE REMSEN. Grade II. Purse \$300,000 FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2017 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Remsen has also been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Derby Championship Series Prep Season. The winner of the Remsen will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 4 points, the third place finisher 2 points and the fourth place finisher 1 point. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at a mile or over other than state-bred stake allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 12, 2016 with 22 Nominations.

MO TOWN raced three wide on the clubhouse bend, rapidly moved up to latch on to TAKAFUL as the tempo softened during the setting of the second split, was patiently ridden keeping an eye on that foe all throughout the run around the far turn, narrowed in after three-quarters had been reached, spun into the lane directly alongside the one to catch, challenged in earnest when switched over to a drive in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, took charge during the ensuing sixteenth, steadily added to the margin, kept busy to the end. NO DOZING hung out three wide on the first turn, made his way around the subsequent one from path four wide, swung as wide into the stretch, gained ground belatedly while securing second. TAKAFUL spurted away from the competition after the start, cut over to the rail, held his largest advantage between calls on the backstretch, was joined up by the top one at midpoint, continued to be rated along showing the way, with the winner in attendance two wide, had that rival close in after more than halfway around the second bend, met a stern bid shortly after stepping into the stretch, succumbed then weakened into the show slot. WIN WITH PRIDE raced three wide on both turns, altered course towards the center of the strip in midlane, made no headway. YOU'RE TO BLAME two wide and put to encouragement on the far turn, was never involved. TALE OF SILENCE broke approximately a length the slowest, made it over to the rail before arriving at the end of the homestretch, displayed some acceleration proceeding to shift into the three path past the three-eighths pole, wound up five wide a furlong later but soon flattened out. TELLMEAFOOKYSTORY saved ground, failed to pick it when asked to at the midway point on the far turn. HOOKUP brushed up the break, raced along the outside, was in the three path when called upon at the three-eighths pole, came up empty. NEWMAN chased the pace from the two path, entered the stretch being fully roused and gave way. LEAD ASTRAY mostly three wide on the first turn, was in the two path by the second one, never reached a contending position.
