

1 MILE. (1.331) 93RD RUNNING OF THE PAT DAY MILE. PRESENTED BY LG&E AND KU. Grade III. Purse \$250,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry. \$1,250 to pass the entry box; \$1,250 additional to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes since October 2, allowed 3 lbs.; \$59,500 at a mile or over in 2017, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Pat Day Mile will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest career earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 15, 2017 with 55 nominations.

WILD SHOT tracked four wide, drew even entering the stretch, shook off UNCONTESTED nearing the furlong marker and widened. NO DOZING was fractious in the gate, broke slow, shifted out five wide to be clear, commenced his rally circling nine wide into the stretch, kicked on well but failed to menace the winner. UNCONTESTED opened clear, set the pace off of the inside, was collared entering the stretch, was unable to go on with the winner, weakened further in the final furlong and settled for the show. YOU'RE TO BLAME was unhurried into stride, made his bid circling nine wide and was making up ground. SONIC MULE was allowed to settle, rallied between horses and improved position. WARRIOR'S CLUB tucked in leaving the chute, got through but lacked a response when called upon. LOCAL HERO contended along the inside, checked when in tight near the half mile marker, quickly leveled back into stride, angled out entering the stretch but came up empty. COLONELSDARKTEMPEM contended off of the inside, but came up empty between horses before going six furlongs and tired. RAPID DIAL was forwardly placed along the inside through the turn and dropped out. BITUMEN broke slow and passed only the tiring ones. EXCITATIONS settled between horses, angled out leaving the turn, but caved between runners. BOBBY ON FLEEK broke slow, rushed up six wide, was within striking distance for six furlongs and stopped.
