1 MILE. ( 1.321 ) 100TH RUNNING OF THE DWYER. Grade III. Purse \$400,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$4,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The guaranteed purse of \$400,000 will be divided accordingly; \$220,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth, \$8,000 to sixth with the remaining \$8,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2017, 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2017, 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 24, 2017 with 13 Nominations.

PRACTICAL JOKE rated just off the pace just off the inside, tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to go patiently handled through the turn, swung three to four wide into upper stretch in behind foes before tipping out to the five path three-sixteenths from home roused, rallied to be the outermost of a quartet stacked across the track nearing the sixteenth marker, took command near that station and edged clear to the finish kept busy to the wire. TALE OF SILENCE brushed the near side stall at the start, settled just off the inside at the tail of the compact field, tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to go remaining on hold until put to light coaxing shifted to the two path at the three-eighths, angled out four wide nearing the quarter pole put to encouragement advancing to issue a challenge straightened away for home, rallied willingly fighting it out latched on among a quartet from the eighth pole to the sixteenth pole, couldn't match the top one late while prevailing in the battle for the place honors. BATTALION RUNNER broke in at the start and was corrected, established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand just off the inside through sensible splits, remained on hold patiently awaiting a challenge through the turn, had the pressure in behind intensify nearing the quarter pole and got set down spinning just off the inside for home, dug in fending off a pair when joined to the far outside by the eventual winner, fought on inside a trio to the sixteenth pole getting overtaken near that station and kept on to preserve the show honors. GIUSEPPE THE GREAT four wide in aim of the front, got staked out four wide through the turn put to coaxing with three furlongs to go, advanced to take first crack at the aforementioned foe on the lead, swung three wide into upper stretch, dug in between foes through the stretch and weakened in the late stages getting outfinished in the final sixteenth. TRUE TIMBER forwardly placed three wide, advanced in tandem with the aforementioned rival on the leader into the turn to race between foes, came under light coaxing midway on the turn, faded nearing the quarter pole, swung two to three wide at that station and tired in the stretch.
