1 1/8 MILES. (1.463) 54TH RUNNING OF THE JIM DANDY PRESENTED BY NYRA BETS. Grade II. Purse \$600,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$6,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One at a mile or over in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two at a mile or over in 2017 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade Three at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 15, 2017 with 16 Nominations.

GOOD SAMARITAN away cleanly, crossed to the inside a sixteenth after the start and took a serene almost buddhist like approach to the early part of the race loping along while saving ground detached at the tail of the compact field, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, closed in through the latter portion of the far turn, angled out to swing six wide into upper stretch, rallied to collar an embattled trio just inside the eighth pole and edged clear under a drive before being geared down inside the final seventy yards to the finish. GIUSEPPE THE GREAT settled unhurried just off the inside near the rear, came under coaxing as a trio stacked up in front with seven-sixteenths to go, closed in a bit through the latter portion of the turn and swung five wide at the quarter pole, dug in under a drive steadily gaining through to the finish running on to improve his position and secure the place honors. ALWAYS DREAMING established the front from the get go and showed the way in hand along the inside through the first turn before taking to the three path down the backstretch, shook away settling into a comfortable rhythm midway down the backstretch coming under light coaxing as a pair of rivals closed in from the outside nearing the half mile pole, tucked inside and came under ever increasing pressure from PAVEL three deep and CLOUD COMPUTING just off his flank in the two path between foes through the far turn, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch clinging to the front tenaciously to the eighth pole when overtaken by the eventual winner, fought on inside a trio and preserved the show honors despite weakening in the late going. PAVEL tucked to be just off the inside into the opening bend, shifted out five paths off the inside down the backstretch latched on to the outside of CLOUD COMPUTING at times while in hand, came under light coaxing in tandem with that foe and advanced on ALWAYS DREAMING with nine-sixteenths to go latching on half a mile from home, got urged along stacked out three wide outside the top pair through the entirety of the bend, swung four wide into upper stretch lugging in half a path straightened away, dug in fighting on through the length of the drive weakening in the late stages to the finish. CLOUD COMPUTING coaxed from the gate, raced just off the inside through the first turn before shifting four wide down the backstretch on hold and in closest aim of ALWAYS DREAMING who shook away at that juncture into the backstretch, had the rider sneak a peek over his off side shoulder at PAVEL and came under coaxing with nine-sixteenths to go to bid on the front into the far turn in tandem with that rival, came under a drive midway on the turn upping the pressure significantly between foes through the bend, spun three wide into upper stretch bumping lightly with ALWAYS DREAMING straightening away, dug in fighting on head to head through to the wire between foes and weakened in the late stages.
