POSTULATION hugged the rail from the start sitting well rated off the pace for most of the race, took control with ease at the half and maintained control into the stretch, drew off when asked for more. TAGHLEEB ran towards the rear sticking to the rail most of the way, moved up closer to contention with half a mile to go, swung for home going three wide and ran all out through the finish. KEYSTONEFORVICTORY was allowed to settle off the pace going two wide around all three turns, vied for the lead at the quarter pole then retreated. TOBIAS hugged the rail the whole way and was allowed to settle off the pace but lacked the needed rally. BULLARDS ALLEY was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack, went around every turn either two or three wide, checked near the five eighths pole when APPLICATOR suddenly ducked out, recovered after a couple strides then came up empty when asked for more. ALPHA WARRIOR went around the first two turns going two and three wide while running towards the rear, had no response when asked for more turning for home and was eased down the lane. APPLICATOR tracked the pace while going very wide around every turn, suddenly ducked out at the five eighths pole interfering with BULLARD'S ALLEY, got back into stride and went wide once again turning for home then came up empty was eased down the lane. CREWMAN was quick to take an easy lead for the first half of the race, stayed on the rail the whole way but was out of gas at the five eighths pole and then was eased from there.
