VOODOO SONG broke in and bumped with a rival, quickly sprinted clear, rounded the first turn in the two path, opened up a sizable advantage, saw the lead diminish late on the backstretch, was challenged into the far turn, vied in the two path on that bend, shook clear again into the stretch, remained clear into the final furlong, was put to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and just held under strong urging. YOSHIDA (JPN) bumped lightly with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer as the field bunched late on the backstretch, waited while held up behind horses in the two path on the far turn, swung five wide while roused into the stretch, rallied on the outside under a right-handed whip and closed strongly but just missed. BRICKS AND MORTAR was last away then shut-off by two opponents, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled well off the pace, moved to the outside of the field before the five-eighths, made an early move and advanced quickly late on the backstretch, vied four then three wide on the far turn, chased the winner in the drive and finished with good courage for the show. ROCKETRY went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. MR HAVERCAMP was reserved on the inside in the second flight, advanced closer to the leader late on the backstretch, was taken in hand while off heels into the far turn, came under urging shortly thereafter, chased against the hedge into the final furlong and also lacked the needed kick. MAKARIOS was taken in hand early, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled well back on the outside, was urged along midway down the backstretch, went four wide on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and failed to threaten. CAVIAR CZAR (IRE) went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, made a bid between horses near the three-eighths, chased three then two wide on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and came up empty. MASTER PLAN bobbed at the start then bumped with a rival, saved ground on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and was no factor. FRACTIONS WERE UNAVAILABLE AND FINAL TIME WAS HAND-TIMED DUE TO TIMER MALFUNCTION
