INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers.123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade Two on the turf in 2017 allowed 5 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 23, 2017 with 22 Nominations.

YOSHIDA (JPN) tracked the pace along the inside under rating patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, came under light coaxing at that station, was in behind foes nearing the eighth pole when FROSTMOURNE shied out under a near sided stick, got roused through in tandem with BRICKS AND MORTAR to his inside sharing a seam not fit for a pair of rivals, had FROSTMOURNE come inwards slightly under an off sided stick and was paused in tight shoulder to shoulder with BRICKS AND MORTAR as that rival briefly steadied, got roused a sixteenth from home among a quintet latched on to one another and surged between foes splitting them in the shadow of the wire to get up and prevail with good courage. LUCULLAN three to four wide just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, went four wide into upper stretch, rallied the outermost of a quintet through the final furlong latched on to one another, dug in under a drive willingly but was ultimately repelled to the wire. BRICKS AND MORTAR three then two wide in reserve in mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home behind foes, had a seam open up nearing the eighth pole and was roused on through squeezing shoulder to shoulder with YOSHIDA to his outside through a seam barely big enough for the both of them, had FROSTMOURNE come in slightly under an off sided stick and was steadied briefly in tight just inside the eighth pole, got put to a drive nearing the sixteenth marker bullying his way through the seam and forcing SECRETARY OF WAR to concede some of the inside in the late stages while showing good courage to secure the show honors. FROSTMOURNE two to three wide in closest range of the leader, got set down spinning three wide at the head of the stretch, rallied to issue a challenge nearing the eighth pole, seized command and shied out under a near sided stick at that station, came under correction and shied in under an off sided stick placing both BRICKS AND MORTAR and YOSHIDA in tight between foes, dug in under assault from a quartet and then a trio and was nailed in the final jumps and forced to settle for the last major share. SECRETARY AT WAR showed the way in hand along the inside through sensible splits patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, cornered just off the inside for home roused for the drive, dug in under a drive and was headed a furlong out, fought on inside a quartet to the finish getting put in tight a sixteenth out and forced to steady and concede some of the inside while being outfinished in the very late going. ROCKETRY saved ground near the rear of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, went seven wide at the head of the stretch, passed tired rivals in the drive. SMALL BEAR just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing tucked inside at the three-eighths, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and offered no response. TICONDEROGA brushed the off side stall at the start getting away slow and conceding three lengths to the front, settled two then three wide at the tail of the field early on, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide at the quarter pole, made no impact. HIEROGLYPHICS two to three wide through the opening bend, settled four wide in the clear down the backstretch, tucked to be just off the inside into the far turn, came under a ride midway on that bend, swung three to four wide at the top of the stretch and came up empty.
