WAR FLAG tracked inside through the opening bend before tracking the top pair two to three wide down the backstretch under rating in closest aim of that pair, remained out three wide into the far turn and came under coaxing midway on that bend, advanced through the latter portion of the turn to swing four to five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge through the final eighth wearing down GRAND JETE to take command inside the final sixteenth joined outside by DACITA latching on and was briefly between rivals, dug in gamely to repel that challenge to the wire. DACITA (CHI) broke out a step at the start bumping ZHUKOVA, saved ground in reserve near the rear of the field, remained patiently handled until put to coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled out through the latter portion of the turn to swing six wide at the head of the stretch, closed well through the final eighth but was ultimately rebuffed at the finish. GRAND JETE (GB) established the front and showed the way under a firm hold along the inside through the first turn before taking to the two path down the backstretch while under attendance to the outside from the latched on ZHUKOVA, remained patiently handled into the far turn coming under light coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths as ZHUKOVA got busy outside when joined three deep by the eventual winner, swung three wide into upper stretch under pressure for the initial time shaking off her escort inching away briefly into upper stretch, dug in confronted by WAR FLAG a furlong out, staved off that rival until displaced inside the final sixteenth, then kept on to just preserve the show honors. BEAULY (GB) bumped lightly at the start by GUILTY TWELVE who broke in a step, saved ground at the tail of the field patiently handled until put to urging three furlongs from home, angled out six wide into upper stretch following DACITA, kicked on belatedly and just missed for the show honors. GUILTY TWELVE broke in at the start bumping lightly with BEAULY, tracked the pace from the two path in hand until put to coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. ZHUKOVA (IRE) bumped at the break by DACITA who broke outwards a step, came under light coaxing to be forwardly placed just off the inside through the first turn latching on to attend GRAND JETE to the outside, raced three wide down the backstretch in hand lightly prompting the leader nearing the far turn, got joined outside by WAR FLAG with three furlongs remaining and was put to urging nearing the five-sixteenths, swung three to four wide into upper stretch getting shaken off by the top pair just prior to straightening away for home, then weakened through to the finish.
