

1/8 MILES. (1481) ONTARIO DERBY Grade III. Purse \$125,000 (plus \$25,000 State Red) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$125 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,250 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 three times at a mile or over in 2017, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2017, 5 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 once at a mile or over in 2017, 7 lbs. TIZ A SLAM bumped into UNDULATED at the start, stalked the pace while racing three-wide on the clubhouse turn, maintained position down the backstretch, began his advance at the 5/16ths pole still racing three-wide, took the lead heading into the stretch, opened up his advantage and was clear to the wire. HOLY HELENA was taken back early, raced between foes, was pinched back by COLONEL SAMSEN heading into the opening turn, raced four-wide on that turn, continued to race near the back down the backstretch, began her advance at the 3/8ths pole racing three-wide, angled out to be five-wide in upper stretch where she had reached contention but could not reach the leader and held on for place. GUY CABALLERO was at the back early, raced two-wide on the clubhouse turn where he advanced into midpack, maintained position down the backstretch, commenced a rally on the far turn, split foes at the 1/4 pole while angling from two to four-wide, finished gamely and missed place. SENIOR INVESTMENT was bumped by UNDULATED at the start, raced at the back and was in a bit tight entering the opening turn, raced three-wide on that turn, went to the rail heading into backstretch racing near the back, attempted to advance into the pack along the rail nearing the far turn, found himself boxed in on that turn as GRIZZEL began to tire and the wall of horses to his outside left him with nowhere to go causing him to be shuffled to the back entering the stretch, angled to the outside in early stretch, bumped into COLONEL SAMSEN past the 3/16ths pole and chased to the wire. UNDULATED was bounced between TIZ A SLAM and SENIOR INVESTMENT at the start, got out to show some speed, pressed the leader while racing two-wide on the opening turn, duled briefly entering the backstretch, tracked the pacesetter down the backstretch, raced two-wide on the far turn, was three-wide in upper stretch, fell back a bit early in the stretch, took a slight steady at the 1/8th pole and passed a tiring foe late. GORGEOUS KITTEN showed speed along the rail, got out to set the pace while saving ground, duled briefly heading into the backstretch but soon had the lead to himself again, was headed late on the far turn and gave way. GRIZZEL (IRE) was out alertly, found a nice stalking position racing covered up along the rail, saved ground on both turns but began to tire on the far turn and had nothing to offer down the stretch. COLONEL SAMSEN was at the back early, bumped into HOLY HELENA entering the clubhouse turn, advanced into midpack while racing four-wide, was carried from four to six-wide late on the far turn, took a bump by SENIOR INVESTMENT past the 3/16ths pole and was empty late. COOL CATOMINE broke in midpack but was at the back while racing five-wide into the opening turn, trailed the field entering the backstretch, continued to lose ground, was distanced and walked off
