

1 MILE. (1.331) 94TH RUNNING OF THE PAT DAY MILE PRESENTED BY LG&E AND KU. Grade III. Purse \$300,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes since October 2, allowed 3 lbs.; \$59,500 at a mile or over in 2018, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Pat Day Mile will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest career earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 14, 2018 with 58 nominations.

FUNNY DUCK stumbled at the start, tucked in to save ground, made a steady advance into contention, brushed the rail near the seven-sixteenths pole, soldiered on undaunted through the turn, shifted out and split horses with three-sixteenths to run, took over nearing the furlong marker and widened. NEW YORK CENTRAL attended the pace along the inside, got through and opened a clear lead leaving the turn, continued on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. GIVEMEAMIN settled off of the inside, angled in midway through the turn, got through along the rail entering the stretch, moved off of the fence late and kept on well. SPORTING CHANCE was allowed to settle, checked between horses near the five furlong marker, recovered and made a sweeping move through the turn, came eight wide and was making up ground. SHANE ZAIN was allowed to settle, moved up between rivals to make his bid, but flattened during the drive. LOMBO set the pressured pace off of the inside, weakened between foes in the final furlong and gave way. SEAHENGE was allowed to settle, advanced in traffic through the turn, but failed to sustain the drive once straightened. MASK contended five wide through the turn and tired. MISSISSIPPI was bumped at the start, settled between horses, steadied leaving the seven-sixteenths pole and came up empty thereafter. MADISON'S LUNA brushed the gate and bobbed at the start, moved into contention between horses, was within reach for six furlongs and retreated. SMART REMARK was bumped at the start, recovered quickly and vied between horses to the turn and dropped out. RESTORING HOPE was hustled along six wide for six furlongs and caved. GREYVITOS contested the pace four wide through the turn and hoped. NATIONAL FLAG showed little.
