SMOKE 'N' GLOAT dueled for the lead on the outside, shook clear from rivals at the top of the stretch and won driving. DON'T SPLIT TENS tracked the pace, responded well when asked for more finishing with a good effort and proved to be second best. CAT'S RUNAWAY was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack while hugging the rail but lacked the needed rally when asked. GO OSHIE GO hit the gate at the start but quickly recovered to get up and duel for the led on the inside, angled out sharply at the quarter pole then surrendered. ON THE LAM was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack, lost her hole at the quarter pole then finished evenly. R FAST LIFE was never a threat. ALL STRIKES broke in a tangle then trailed the field, had no response when asked and was eased down the lane. RIV was forwardly placed in the stages but came up empty at the quarter pole and was eased down the lane.
