1 1/16 MILES. (1.41) 4TH RUNNING OF THE HEAVENLY PRIZE INVITATIONAL. Purse \$150,000 INNER DIRT FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no subscription fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2016-17 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$60,000 since August 1, 2016 allowed 5 lbs.; of \$60,000 since January 1, 2016 or two races in 2017 allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and State-Bred allowance races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

ISABELLE was the quickest out of the starting gate, was content to set up in the three path heading for the top of the clubhouse turn, hanging out the closest pursuer at the time, that being the runner up, to her outside, slid swiftly to the rail soon afterwards, with GENRE following suit by shifting closer to the rail herself, sailed along, rated on a loosely-contested setting the next fractions, began to shake off the others as three-quarters was being completed, saw the pilot chilly in the saddle from that juncture to the three-sixteenths pole, even as the closest chasers were all being set down themselves, responded with gusto when put to a drive, drawing off convincingly, finished the seventy yards well wrapped up and en route to winning with a much the best designation. GENRE almost abreast of the top one at the time, stepped off the homestretch from the four path, kept there by the riding tactics used by pilot of the winner at the time, managed to tuck into path two after a few more additional strides, chased the winner, without ever being hitched up close enough to apply any pressure of note, was called upon for much more as the winner began to extend the margin in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, lost contact even further once into the stretch but held on well to garner the place. CHORUS LINE lunged out at the start, rode the rail, was put to a brisk hand ride past the three-eighths pole, failed to keep up with the leader then weakened into the show slot. OASIS AT MIDNIGHT stayed along the rail after the start, took the inside route for over six furlongs, fanned outward after enteriing the lane until seven wide by the final stages, rallied mildly for the last major check. ANNIE ROCKS off the inside, tipped into the three path proceeding along the backstretch, scurried herself into contention with a three wide run from the half mile pole to midpoint on the far turn, went into the two path by the conclusion of the maneuver and flattened out. FAMILYOFROSES unhurried in the two path, never made an impact.
