

7 FURLONGS. (1.194) 40TH RUNNING OF THE BOUWERIE. Purse \$125,000 FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD FOALD IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,250 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 4 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 13, 2017 with 24 Nominations.

HOLIDAY DISGUISE bumped solidly at the start and pinched between foes due to NOBLE FREUD veering in at the start and in turn bumped NORTH END into FROSTY GAL, chased six paths off the inside early on until tucking four wide five furlongs from home, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out continuing four wide, angled seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final eighth drifting out a sixteenth from home, collared the leader inside that station and prevailed going away at the end. NOBLE FREUD veered in at the start bumping the aforementioned foe soundly and pinching that rival back while commencing a chain of bumping down through TONI TOOLS, established the front and showed the way in hand three then two wide through the turn, got set down spinning four wide at the quarter pole, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in under lone threat and was collared inside the sixteenth marker and forced to settle for the place honors. TIZNOW'S SMILE four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole, angled six wide into upper stretch advancing to striking range, ran on to secure the show honors. WILBURNMONEY just off the pace five then four wide through the turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. TIMELY TRADITION bumped at the start by SWING AND SWAY and in turn bumped BLUEGRASS FLAG, chased three wide under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened. BLUEGRASS FLAG bumped at the start by TIMELY TRADITION due to pressure from SWING AND SWAY breaking outwards, prompted the leader four wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths, swung three wide into upper stretch, tired in the drive. NORTH END broke in at the start bumping FROSTY GAL then got bumped at the start by HOLIDAY DISGUISE due to the pressure of the veering inwards NOBLE FREUD and in turn bumped FROSTY GAL once more but this time into TONI TOOLS, chased four wide early on until tucked to the inside five furlongs from home, came under coaxing just off the inside midway on the turn, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no rally. SWING AND SWAY broke out at the start bumping TIMELY TRADITION into BLUEGRASS FLAG, chased just off the inside forwardly placed coming under urging with five-sixteenths remaining, continued just off the inside for home and faltered in the stretch. FROSTY GAL bumped at the start by NORTH END, then got bumped a second time and pinched lightly back due to the inward pressure of NOBLE FREUD, chased three wide early on until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing three furlongs out, cut the corner into upper stretch and made no impact. TONI TOOLS bumped at the start by FROSTY GAL due to pressure from the outside, got squeezed back and chased four then three wide coming under a ride seven-sixteenths from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
