

1 MILE. (1.321) 4TH RUNNING OF THE CRITICAL EYE. PURSE \$200,000 FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD FOALING IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 117 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2016-17 or \$150,000 since October 1, 2016 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2016-17 allowed 5 lbs.; of four races other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 7 lbs.; of three such races allowed 9 lbs. KATHRYN THE WISE vied from the five path in hand outside a pair down the backstretch, tucked three wide into the turn knocking heads briefly with PLAY ME A MEMORY before shaking away midway on the bend widening to a clear advantage, swung four wide into upper stretch and was roused three-sixteenths out, went clear under a brief drive before being taken in hand through the final sixteenth to finish under her own power, the outcome in no doubt. LITERATA five then six wide on the turn, came under urging three furlongs from home and moved in tandem with BEE NOTEWORTHY to her inside into prominence swinging five wide for home, proved no match for the top one while running on to finish clear of the rest and second best. BEE NOTEWORTHY five wide down the backstretch in pursuit, chased four wide through the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths, advanced in tandem with the aforementioned for into contention swinging four wide into upper stretch, proved unable to threaten the top rival while keeping on for the show honors. WUNDERMENT brushed the near side stall at the start getting away a bit awkwardly, chased three wide until tucked inside half a mile from home, briefly paused in tight inside of the backing away BIG MARA at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, angled nine wide into upper stretch and passed tired foes belatedly for the last major share. JC'S SHOOTING STAR chased just off the inside until angled out four wide seven-sixteenths from home put to urging, swung seven wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. PICCO UNO chased five then four wide from just off the pace, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled towards the inside to swing just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. DAISY CUTTER three wide at the rear, got coaxed along with seven-sixteenths to run, angled eight wide into upper stretch, improved position by tired rivals in the stretch. TRICKY ZIPPY five to six wide in pursuit from near the rear, got coaxed along through the turn five wide, swung out ten paths into upper stretch and made no impact. BIG MARA vied three then two wide early on inside a pair, came under coaxing half a mile from home fading, swung four wide into upper stretch and gave way. JULES N ROME forwardly placed three to four wide, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled six wide at the quarter pole and folded. PLAY ME A MEMORY vied four then three wide between foes early on, pressed the issue from the two path into the turn lightly coaxed along head to head with KATHRYN THE WISE to her outside as BIG MARA backed away, got shaken off midway on the turn, retreated through the latter portion and spun just off the inside for home, then faltered in the stretch.
