OFFERING PLAN well off the inside throughout, raced three wide on the chute, followed the lead of KING KREESA and shifted one path farther off the rail arriving at the conclusion of the backstretch, picked up interest as six furlongs was being completed, was cued up swinging five wide into the lane, kicked into his best stride and began to narrow in, got hooked up in a duel with the runner up, wrested away the advantage inside the sixteenth poie and edged away. KING KREESA broke alertly, raced heads apart with MACAGONE for a short time before being conceded the top by that foe, cut over closer to the rail once safely in the clear, carved out the pace, spotted at a slight distance from off the rail, and other than pulling a bit on the left of the bit, rating well, inched his way into the two path in time for the run around the full turn, held the closest pursuers at bay, got turned loose spinning into the lane, went at it with the winner from midstretch onward, got headed a short distance past the sixteenth marker, flashed good courage the rest of the way to the wire to secure second. LUBASH appeared to come away in good order, drafted behind KING KREESA for the opening three-quarters, was forced to remain on hold approaching the quarter pole, lacking the best of options, saw clearance along the inside route deep into the furlong grounds and eagerly dove over to the rail, finished willingly for the show, although no match for the top twosome today. KHARAFKA underwent a three wide journey for six furlongs, powered up into contention with a sustained run from the half mile pole, spun slightly wider into the stretch, maintained the momentum for another furlong before flattening out. MACAGONE engaged in an early abbreviated pace contest with the runner up, was taken back, tipped to be outside that one, put on the pressure all the way to the quarter pole and gave way. WICKED FREUD two wide and between rivals for three-quarters, had no rally. IRON POWER stumbled badly as the field was sent on its way, quickly tucked along the inside route, cut the corner into the lane and had no rally. MARK MY STYLE took up the chase from the two path for six furlongs, got sent out into path five from upper to midlane, failed to menace.
