SONGBIRD out-broke the competition and retained the advantage, sat entrenched three to four wide along the backstretch setting the initial fractions, shifted onto path two nearing the half mile pole, got pounced upon by PAID UP SUBSCRIBER midpoint, fell back by as much as a long neck a sixteenth later, completed the rest of short run to the end of the bend with the rider holding something in reserve, same as the nemesis, had that foe's pilot commit to a drive first, this occurring just as the pair started to spin into the lane, re-claimed the advantage during the ensuing furlong, lightly hand urged by this juncture, was set down to a brisker hand ride with approximately a sixteenth remaining and edged clear. PAID UP SUBSCRIBER shadowed the winner from off the inside and to its left during the initial stages, closed in and fully hitched up to the winner with a furlong remaining on the backstretch, moved over to the rail at the top of the turn, unleashed a bold bid coming to the three-eighths pole, pilot only mildly encouraging the mount, inched her way to a narrow lead as three-quarters was being reached, was put to a drive coming into the lane in a practical dead heat with the top one, reluctantly relinquished during the tussle that followed over the next eighth, was stubborn to the end, but had to settle for being second best. HIGHWAY STAR rode the rail to the quarter pole, was put to a more and more energetic ride making her way around the turn until under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, angled out heading for the top of the lane, out-raced CARINA MIA for path four, continued to spar side by side with that opponent the rest of the way to the finish line, came out about a path in deep stretch, was straightened away right away and got the show. CARINA MIA came away from the gate in good order, stepped onto the turn from the three path, shifted slightly wider turning into the stretch, was gently nudged out a bit more after being beaten to position by HIGHWAY STAR soon afterwards, winding up in path five by the three-sixteenths marker, remained engaged with the previously-named rival for show honors, shied out slightly with seventy yards to go, after HIGHWAY STAR momentarily came out towards her in the midst of a full drive, proceeded onward for the last major check. VERVE'S TALE took up the chase two wide on the bend, was under a drive coming from path three into the stretch, made no headway. FACTORY OF FAITH raced sluggishly along the chute, was four wide entering the turn and sent seven wide exiting it, made no impact. BAR OF GOLD settled into midpack after the field had been sent on its way, worked out a tuck into the two path at the half mile pole, sat within range of the front runners, got called upon for the drive and came up empty.
