

1 1/8 MILES. (Turf) (1.38) 31ST RUNNING OF THE PALM BEACH. GRADE III. PURSE \$100,000 THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, February 19. \$750 to enter and \$250 to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs., a stakes race, 4 lbs., two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

TICONDEROGA was last to begin and two wide into the first turn, was eased back under a strong hold between horses approaching the backstretch, moved willingly to contention under mild urging through the far turn, tipped three wide outside ADONIS CREED into the stretch, gathered a full head of steam under left-handed pressure and caught the leaders inside the sixteenth pole to win going away. KITTEN'S CAT bumped lightly with SNAP DECISION at the start, pressed the pace outside SAILING HOME for six furlongs, battled for the lead outside that one from the quarter pole to deep stretch and held well while no match for the winner late. SNAP DECISION was bumped lightly between rivals at the start, trailed toward the inside for six furlongs, angled off the inside just behind TICONDEROGA into the lane, found his best stride after switching leads a sixteenth out and finished well to be up for third. SAILING HOME recovered from a bobble at the start to get the lead through the stretch the first time, set a pressured pace inside to late on the far turn, responded when challenged by KITTEN'S CAT, dueled inside that one past the furlong grounds and weakened late. GIANT PAYDAY saved ground in the second flight for six furlongs, moved three to four wide late on the far turn and rallied mildly outside without threatening. ADONIS CREED prompted the pace three wide around the turns and faded in the stretch. COWBOY CULTURE was difficult to load and restless once in the gate, broke alertly and was eased back yielding inside SAILING HOME headed to the first turn, raced within easy striking distance for six furlongs and tired. CHANNEL MAKER bumped with SNAP DECISION at the start, raced in midpack two wide to the stretch and lacked a response. PAGLIACCI broke in at the start bumping with CHANNEL MAKER, raced three wide early, moved from the four-path toward the inside nearing the stretch and could not keep pace.
