

1 1/8 MILES. (1.402) 21ST RUNNING LONE STAR PARK HANDICAP. Grade III. Purse \$200,000 (PLUS UP TO \$11,250 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start (the start fee will be waived for any horse starting in the 2017 Texas Mile) with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$110,000 to the owner of the winner, \$38,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$11,500 to fourth, \$5,500 to fifth and \$3,000 for placing sixth through tenth. If less than ten horses start, the purse monies not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weights: Sunday, May 14, 2017. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. First preference to horses finishing first, second, third and fourth in the 2017 Texas Mile; second preference to high weights; third preference to horses starting in the 2017 Texas Mile of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

DANZING CANDY came away in good order then was hustled to the front, chose the three path on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, rounded the far turn in the three path while under coaxing, responded well when shaken up in upper stretch, drew off under a hand ride into the final sixteenth then cruised to the wire with the rider poised like a statue in the irons to win handily. TEXAS CHROME went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the inside of SHOTGUN KOWBOY, was urged along in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch under the whip and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. SHOTGUN KOWBOY went around the first turn in the four path, tracked the pace on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths, chased in the four path on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and tired while clear for the show. NECK 'N NECK traveled around the first turn in the three path, settled off the pace, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and came up empty. CAROUSE dropped back early, saved ground on the first turn, fell well behind, was urged along in the four path on the far turn and showed little.
