TIMELINE bobbled slightly at the break, then set the pace on the inside, responded when asked in upper stretch, pulled away to a comfortable lead and was ridden out. TALK LOGISTICS was in a bit tight along the rail on the first turn, moved up inside to track the pace, slipped off the rail at the quarter pole, rallied two wide into the stretch, dug in gamely but was clearly second best. HONOR THE FLEET pulled three wide early, then stalked two wide, was asked on the far turn, weakened and just held on to earn the show. GLORY STARS raced off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, continued on the rail, lacked a rally and just missed for third. GREEK PRINCE was in a bit tight in the early stages, steadied at the five furlong marker, then settled two wide off the pace and tired.
