SIRCAT SALLY stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn to gain the lead, was carried out some into the stretch, kicked clear under left handed urging, drifted in and held. BEAU RECALL (IRE) angled in and chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival into the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well. MISS SUGARS (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came out for room in upper stretch, split rivals in the drive and gained the show, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. BERNINA STAR saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. LA FORCE (GER) stalked three deep on the first turn then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MISS SUNSET sped to the early lead outside, angled in then drifted on the front into the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. GO ON MARY chased between horses or outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn and did not rally. HOW ABOUT ZERO saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked the needed response. SIBERIAN IRIS (IRE) broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MADAM DANCEALOT (IRE) four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. GRAND PRIX chased outside a rival or between foes to the stretch and did not rally. SIMMY'S TEMPLE (GB) angled in and saved ground off the pace to the stretch and lacked a response in the drive.
