

1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) 74TH RUNNING OF THE SHOEMAKER MILE. Grade I. Purse \$400,000 (plus \$690 Other Sources) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination. Closed Saturday, May 20, 2017 with 16. Supplementary nomination of \$8,000 due at time of entry. \$6,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 guaranteed \$240,000 to the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth and \$8,000 to fifth. Three-year-olds 121 lbs. Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I at One Mile or Over since December 3, 2016, allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I or Two Grade II races at One Mile or Over since June 3, 2016, allowed 4 lbs. *The Shoemaker Mile has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup Win and You're In Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Shoemaker Mile will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2017 running of the Breeders' Cup Mile division. The nominated winner will be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived (\$40,000 value) for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend. Winner must be Breeders' Cup nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

BAL A BALI (BRZ) broke out bit, settled inside, saved ground chasing the pace to the second bend, angled out and advanced three then four wide into the stretch, continued charge from off the rail then reeled in leader nearing the wire to be along in time. FARHAAN was squeezed back some leaving the gate, unhurried while guided to the rail, came off the fence on the backstretch then three wide exiting the last turn, rallied effectively from well off the rail in the stretch and got up in final jump for second. HEART TO HEART quickly assumed control, set pace from the inside, inched away around the final bend then padded that cushion further in mid stretch, dug in desperately from the inside late but could not hold the winner then was nailed for the place on the wire. FREE ROSE broke in slightly, gradually worked his way to the way early, stalked from along the fence to the second turn, came out some entering the lane, later regained the rail and was out finished. GANGSTER was off step slow, taken to the rail early, chased in rail-hugging trip to last turn, continued inside into the stretch and failed to threaten late. BOLO stalked while outside rival into backstretch, continued bit off the rail tracking leaders, chased three wide on the last turn then gained the rail in upper stretch and weakened. WHAT A VIEW forced the pace while outside leader into second bend, dropped back some passing quarter marker then gave way readily from between rivals.
