FAITHFULLY content to track pace while outside rival, steadily advanced three wide on the last turn, loomed three wide passing quarter marker, collared leader nearing eighth pole then quickly drew clear while coming in some through the stretch. STREET SURRENDER pulled her way along the rail into and along the backstretch, angled out on second turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied well off the rail through the lane and held rival late for second. PLASTERED was closest pursuer while bit off the fence to the second bend, moved up on last turn, loomed inside winner nearing top of the stretch, came out slightly passing sixteenth pole and went willingly to the wire. COPPA was quickly sent to the front, held clear advantage from the inside into the last turn, had that cushion evaporate around second bend, overtaken nearing eighth marker and weakened along the rail late. SHOW STEALER unhurried early, saved ground while dropping well back into backstretch, later angled out two then three wide into the stretch and never threatened.
