FREE nominations closed Thursday, June 1 with 18 or by supplementary nomination of \$500 at time of entry. \$300 additional to start. The added monies and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$45,000 allowed 2 lbs., \$30,000 at one mile or over since December 10 allowed 4 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

SHARP SAMURAI stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch, bid along the rail under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. CONQUEST FARENHEIT pulled and stalked just off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter leaving the second turn and into the stretch to gain a short lead, was three deep past the eighth pole, drifted in some under right handed urging in deep stretch and held second. MONSTER MAN pulled his way to the early lead, set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, was between foes past the eighth pole, steadied when crowded a sixteenth out and in deep stretch and was outfinished. BIRD IS THE WORD chased three deep then outside a rival, continued just off the rail into the stretch, angled inward in the drive and was outkicked late. GRECIAN FIRE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COMMA SISTER angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. FASHION BUSINESS (GB) chased three deep on the first turn then outside a rival, continued outside a foe on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed response. KINGS RIVER KING pulled his way along inside, saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. MOST DETERMINED squeezed back at the start, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and lacked a response in the drive. PERFECT COME BACK broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside then just off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. RAINBOW SQUALL unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace and was not a factor. Following a stewards' inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of MONSTER MAN against the runner-up for alleged interference in deep stretch, no change was made when the stewards ruled the trouble to the former did not alter the original order of finish.
