DICKINSON settled off the pace while saving ground, moved up along the inside on the far turn, angled out entering the stretch, responded when asked, closed willingly to gain command in midstretch and then edged away under urging. ELYSEA'S WORLD (IRE) raced off the pace while saving ground, advanced inside on the far turn, angled out at the top of the lane and finished well outside to earn place honors. ISABELLA SINGS cruised up to take charge while passing the finish line for the first time, set the pace, responded when asked nearing the quarter pole, dug in gamely when challenged by DICKINSON, but then yielded grudgingly. EVIDENTLY raced two wide off the pace, then saved ground, angled out turning for home and rallied outside to best the others. MY IMPRESSION raced off the pace between rivals, moved up three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the lane, closed mildly and was outkicked for fourth. LIGHT IN PARIS (IRE) angled over leaving the chute, then settled outside a rival, moved up between foes in upper stretch, then lacked a rally. FAMILY MEETING raced off the pace inside, moved through on the rail entering the stretch, then lacked a late response. LOTS O' LEX chased inside and faded. EMERALD POND had a three wide trip and did not factor. SWISS RANGE (GB) pulled and was steadied early, then took back, stalked the pacesetter and gave way at the quarter pole.
