SOUPER TAPIT tracked the leaders while racing several lengths back along the inside, angled out and advanced to stalk the leaders heading into the far turn, commenced a three-wide bid at the 1/4 pole, led into the stretch, was pressed at the furlong pole but rebroke and drew clear. CHANNEL MAKER lacked early speed, raced two-wide on the opening turn, commenced a rally on the far turn ranging from three to five-wide, pressed the leader down the stretch and nearly reached the lead at the 1/8th pole but was outkicked in the final 1/16th. MALIBU SECRET raced in midpack early, was two-wide on the clubhouse turn, advanced to briefly stalk the pace down the backstretch but was back in the middle heading into the far turn, commenced a bid on the far turn ranging from two to four-wide, was in tight in early stretch, angled to the outside for clear running room but failed to threaten the top two. MEGAGRAY raced in midpack, saved ground, angled three-wide midway around the far turn and chased in vain down the stretch under hard urging. MINISTER'S STRIKE trailed the field through the opening fractions, angled off the rail to avoid a tiring MONTU midway around the turn, passed another tiring foe down the stretch but failed to threaten. CONQUEST LEMONRAID attended the early pace while racing two-wide, pressed the leader down the backstretch, made her bid for the lead at the 3/8ths pole and secured it at the 5/16ths but was headed at the 1/4 pole and came up empty in the stretch. MONTU set the early pace, was headed midway around the turn, faltered almost immediately after being headed, was eased across the wire and was walked off.
