GUY CABALLERO dropped back to the rear in the early stages, was three-wide on the clubhouse turn, continued to race on the outside down the backstretch, entered the far turn racing three-wide, commenced a rally nearing the 1/4 pole, angled four-wide turning for home, continued to rally down the stretch, surged within the final furlong and proved best late. KING AND HIS COURT was away in midpack, saved ground on the opening turn, skimmed the rail into contention as they rounded the far turn, stuck with the rail path down the stretch, reached the leader past the 1/8th pole, dueled in the final 1/16th and got the better of STATE OF HONOR but could not hold off GUY CABALLERO, although game to the wire. STATE OF HONOR got out on top and set a rated pace, saved ground on the opening turn, maintained comfortable control of the tempo down the backstretch, came off of the rail late on the far turn, was headed at the 1/16th pole, dueled in late stretch and was outkicked. TIZ A SLAM lacked early speed, raced two-wide on the clubhouse turn, angled out past the half-mile pole, entered the far turn racing two-wide, trailed the field as they approached the 1/4 pole, was on the inside path entering the stretch and finished gamely. AVIE'S MESA bore outwards at the start, raced in midpack, was three and two-wide on the opening turn, commenced a bid while racing three-wide at the 5/16ths pole, appeared to try to lug in at the top of the stretch, failed to reach STATE OF HONOR and flattened out down the lane. EXPEDITION showed brief speed, tracked the pacesetter, raced two-wide on the opening turn, maintained his position down the backstretch, continued to race two-wide into the far turn, began to tire nearing the 5/16ths pole and came up empty in the stretch.
