1 MILE. (1.32) 5TH RUNNING OF THE HEAVENLY PRIZE INVITATIONAL. Purse \$150,000 FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no subscription fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2017-18 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$60,000 since August 1, 2017 allowed 5 lbs.; of \$60,000 since January 1, 2017 or two races in 2018 allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and State-Bred allowance races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

DIVINE MISS GREY responded to some light hand urging after springing from the starting gate to accelerate to the front along the chute, had the rider switch over to a firmer hold after establishing control, sailed along on the front end, kept at a slight distance from off the inside, was allowed to shift from path two to path three during the run around the bend, arrived at the quarter pole with the pilot sitting chilly, in sharp contrast to the frantic encouragement the closest pursuers were being given, was making her way through the furlong grounds when put to a drive, scampered away, kept to a drive thereafter until the final forty yards. HOLIDAY DISGUISE pursued the winner from the four path on the turn, got driven into path five for entrance into the stretch, failed to cut into the deficit while managing to finish well clear of the others for the place. FROST WISE off the inside throughout, stalked the winner three wide, doing so from between rivals for much of the trip on the turn, got angled out six wide for the drive home, lacked the needed response. BOULE departed the backstretch from the two path, had the rider resort to some hand urging by the three-eighths pole, made it into the stretch and came up empty. HIGHWAY STAR guided over to the rail shortly after the start, tracked the winner, coaxed along on the backstretch, was put to a drive coming up to the five-sixteenths pole, angled to the outside spinning onto upper stretch, failed to fire and backed away.
